III. MINUTES OF MEETING:

1. The meeting was held at the Department of Master of Business Administration, NRCM, on 28th November, 2023 at 11:00 a.m, on a Zoom platform.
2. Prof.B.Pramoda Holly Star, Chairman, Board of Studies invited all the members cordially to the meeting.
3. The Chairman of BOS Committee has briefed about the rules and regulations stipulated by UGC and JNTUH, Hyderabad for Autonomous colleges after introducing all the members.
4. The Chairman of BOS presented the proposed Academic Regulations, Course Structure and Detailed syllabus to the board. The board approved the Academic Regulations, Course Structure for NR23 and suggested some changes in the evaluation and distribution of Mid & CIE marks.
5. NR22 Regulations will be regarded as NR23 to be implemented for I MBA class of 2023.
6. The following corrections are done as per the BOS member's recommendations:

Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) shall be made based on the average of the marks secured in the two Mid-Term Examinations conducted, first Mid-Term examinations in the middle of the Semester and second Mid-Term examinations during the last week of instruction.

In CIE, for theory subjects, during a semester, there shall be two mid-term examinations. Each Mid- Term examination consists of two parts i) **Part – A** for 10 marks, ii) **Part – B** for 20 marks with a total duration of 2 hours as follows:

1. Mid-Term Examination for 30 marks:
 - a. Part - A: Short answer Questions for 10 marks.
 - b. Part - B: Descriptive paper for 20 marks.

The remaining 10 marks of Continuous Internal Assessment (out of 40) are distributed as:

2. Assignment for 5 marks. (Average of 2 Assignments each for 5 marks)
3. Seminars/PPT/Poster Presentation/ Case Study/Video presentation/ Survey/Field Study/Group discussion /Role Play on a topic in the concerned subject for 5 marks (Average of 2 activities each for 5 marks)

- Part – A is set with 5 short Questions for a total of 10 marks.
- Part-B The descriptive paper shall contain 6 fullquestions out of which, the student has to answer 4 questions, each carrying 5 marks. The student has to get minimum of 40% on average of two Mid-Term examinations.

While the first mid-term examination shall be conducted on 50% of the syllabus, the second mid-term examination shall be conducted on the remaining 50% of the syllabus.



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











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Five (5) marks are allocated for assignments (as specified by the subject teacher concerned). The first assignment should be submitted before the conduct of the first mid-term examination, and the second assignment should be submitted before the conduct of the second mid-term examination. The average of the two assignments shall be taken as the final marks for assignment (for 5 marks).

Seminars/PPT/Poster Presentation/ Case Study/ Video presentation/ Survey/ Field Study/ Group discussion /Role Play on a topic in the concerned subject for 5 marks (as specified by the subject teacher concerned).

7. Student shall have to earn 40%, i.e. marks out of 16 marks from average of two mid-term examinations (I Mid-Term & II Mid-Term).
