Students admitted from 2021 onwards will follow completely autonomous Regulations, Course Structure and Syllabus.

The council members after detailed discussion approved course structure of CSE, CSE(AI&ML), CSE(CS) and CSE(DS) presented for 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> year students & syllabus for CSE 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> year, for 2<sup>nd</sup> year of CSE (AI&ML), CSE (CS) and CSE (DS) under autonomous syllabus applicable for B. Tech students admitted from 2020 onwards with the suggestion to change the Mandatory Non-Credit Course Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) from 3<sup>rd</sup> year to 4<sup>th</sup> year 1<sup>st</sup> semester for uniform distribution of subjects between the semesters. The suggestion is implemented in all departments curriculum.

- 5 Head of ECE presented the proposed course structure & syllabus for 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> year students under autonomous syllabus applicable for B.Tech students admitted from 2020 onwards.

The council members after detailed discussion approved course structure & syllabus of ECE presented for 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> year students under autonomous syllabus applicable for B.Tech students admitted from 2020 onwards with the following suggestions.

To change the subject title Digital System Design in 2<sup>nd</sup> year 1<sup>st</sup> semester to Digital Logic Design and advised to keep 3 subjects in each electives group along with other courses. The title is changed from Digital System Design in 2<sup>nd</sup> year 1<sup>st</sup> semester to Digital Logic Design for both theory and lab. The electives also kept as 3 in each elective group; subjects are grouped as advised by members.
