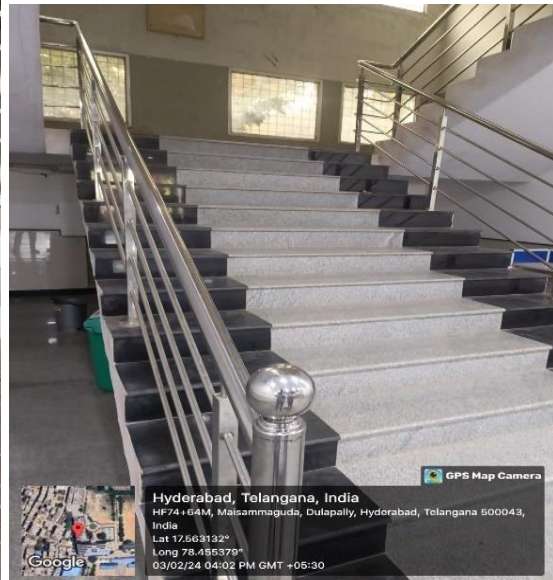
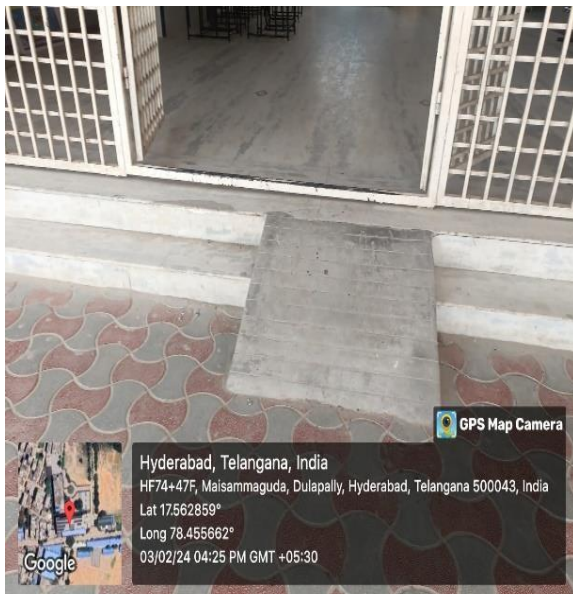
1. Ramps/lifts for easy access to classrooms and centres

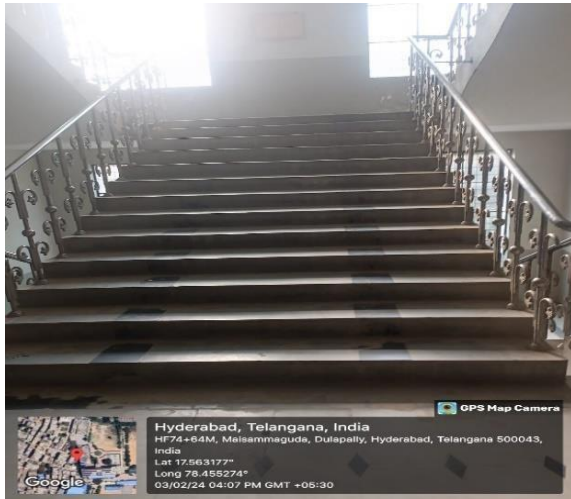

Promotes Inclusivity

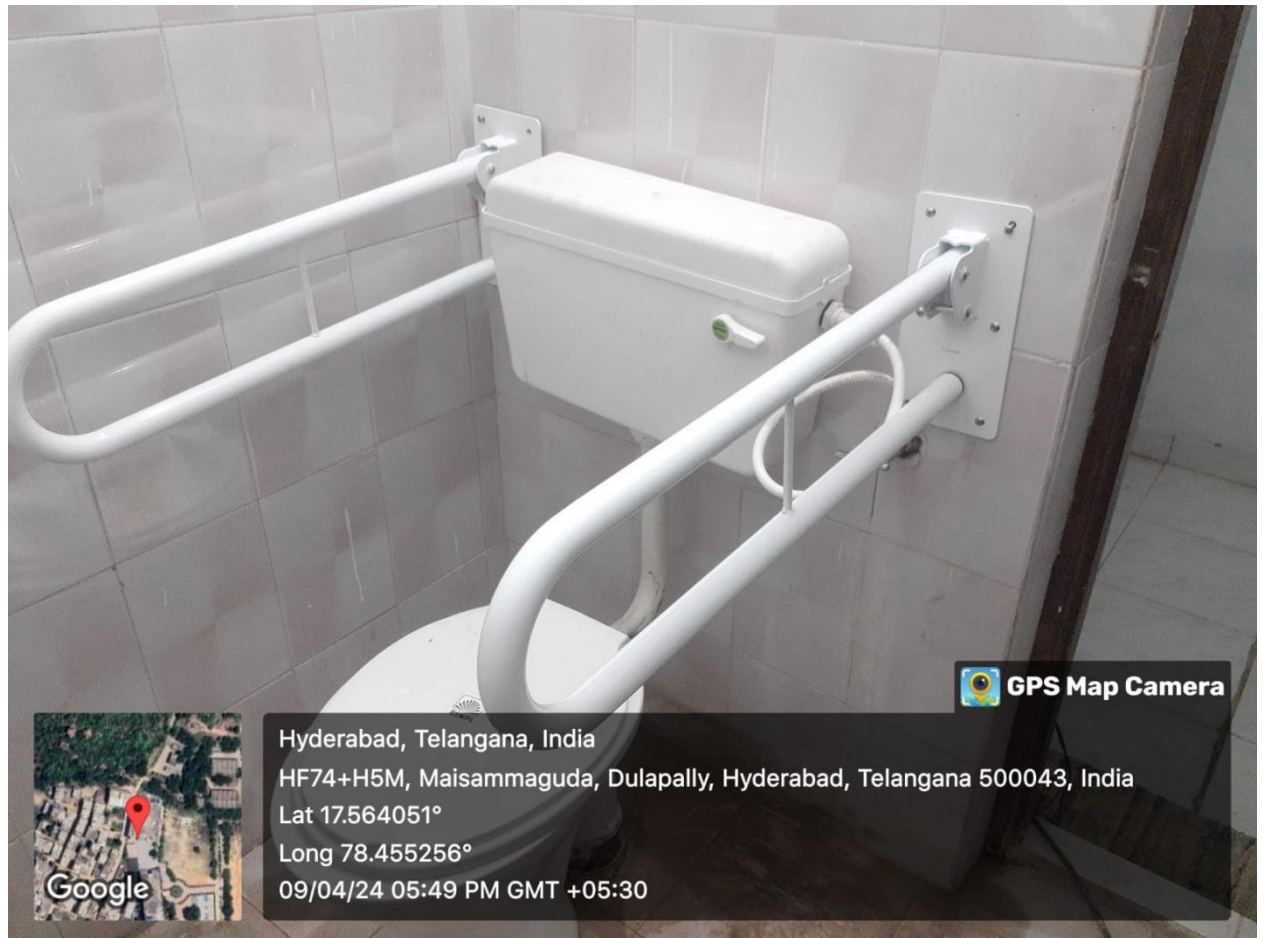
- Creates an inclusive environment where all students, regardless of physical ability, can attend classes and participate fully in academic life.

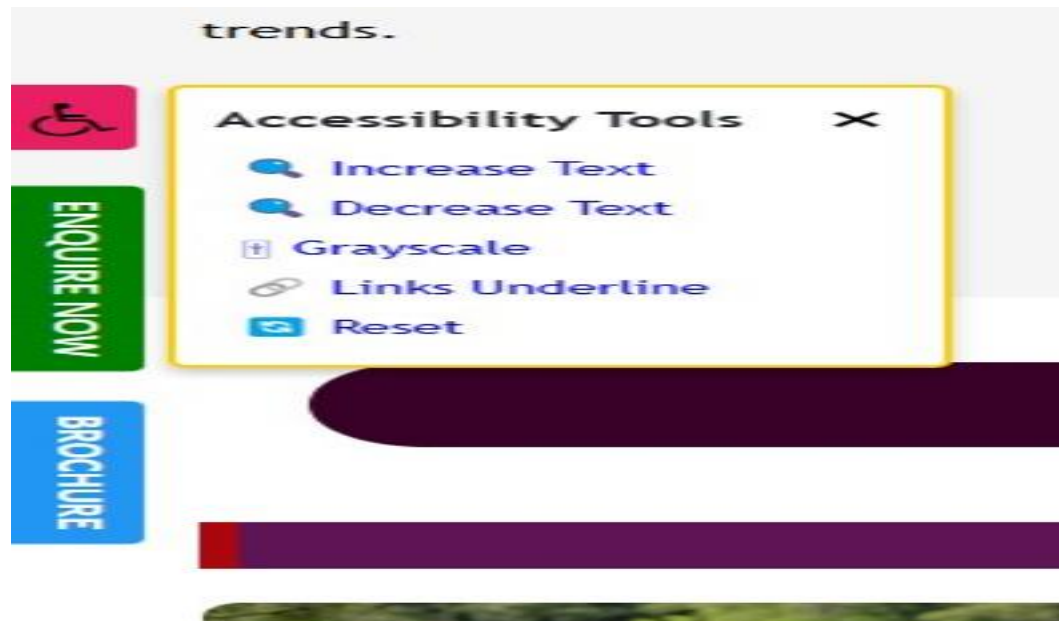

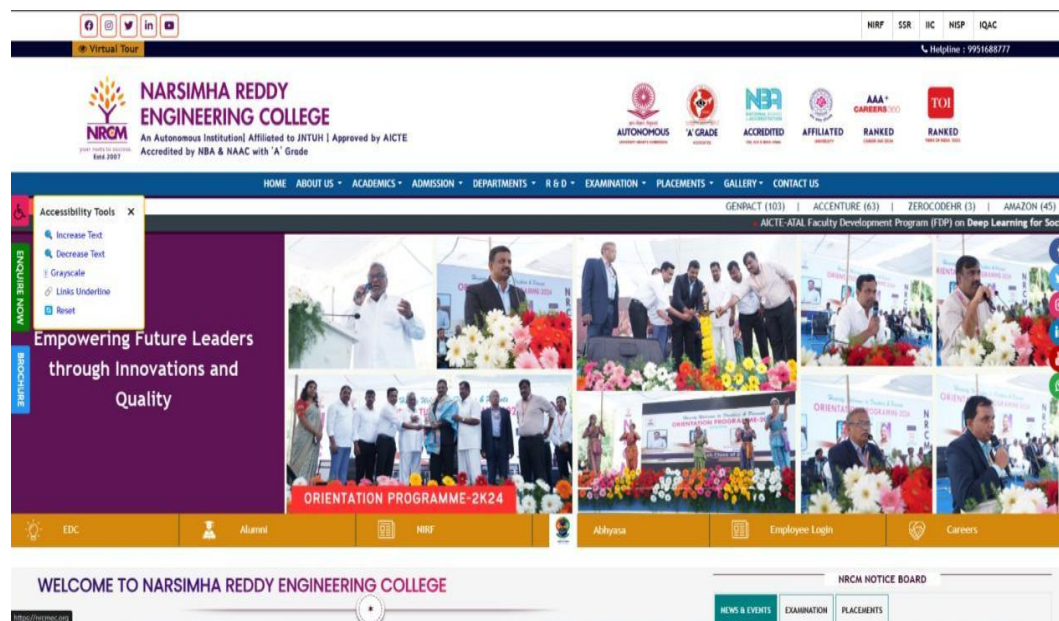
SIGNAGE INCLUDING DISPLAY BOARDS AND SIGNPOSTS



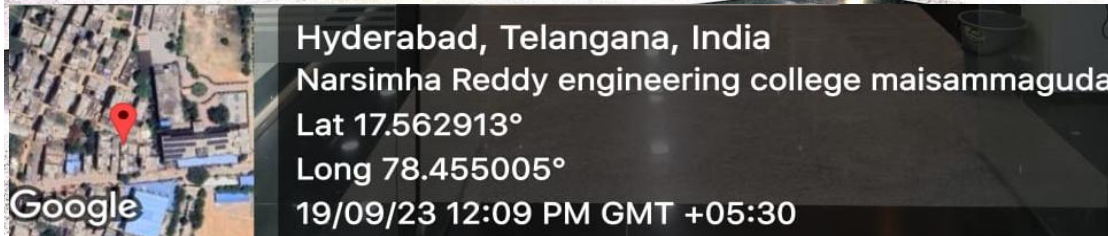
