- (b) The grant is subject to the adjustment on the basis of **Utilisation Certificate (UC) and Statement of Expenditure (SoE)** in the prescribed proforma to be submitted by the University/College/Institution. Further, the accounts of the institute will be open for test check by the Council or Controller & Auditor General of India or any other officer designated by them.
- (c) The amount of the Grant-in-Aid bill shall be disbursed and credited to the account of **Narsimha Reddy Engineering College (Autonomous) Hyderabad , Telangana** through **RTGS**.

## IV. General Instructions


- (a) Minimum number of participants should be 50. There is no limit for maximum participants.



## **Report on Eye Checkup Camp**

A free eye checkup camp was organized at Narsimha Reddy Engineering college on 6th May 2024 to promote awareness about eye health and provide students and staff with essential eye care services.

To assess the eye health of students and faculty.

Participants were advised to take regular breaks from screens, maintain a balanced diet rich in Vitamin A, and undergo periodic eye checkups.

Conclusion:

The eye checkup camp at Narsimha Reddy Engineering college was a great success, benefiting many students and staff members. It raised awareness about eye health and helped identify vision issues at an early stage. The college plans to organize similar health initiatives in the future to ensure overall well-being.
